1) Global Lift Equipment Scholarship - \$500 – 1 Award (Deadline: October 25th, 2013)

To be considered eligible for the Global Lift Equipment Scholarship you must:

- A) Be currently attending or planning on attending a post-secondary institution in Canada or the US in September of 2013 or September of 2014.
- B) Submit a short story. Detailed instructions can be found on the application page.
- C) Have a GPA of 2.5 or greater.

2) Horatio Alger Scholarship - \$21,000 – 50+ Award (Deadline: October 25th, 2013)

To be eligible to apply for the Horatio Alger Scholarship Programs, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Be enrolled full-time as a high school senior in the United States, progressing normally toward graduation in spring/summer of 2014 with plans to enter a college in the United States no later than the fall following graduation
- 2. Exhibit a strong commitment to pursue and complete a bachelor's degree at an accredited non-profit public or private institution in the United States (students may start their studies at a two-year institution and then transfer to a four-year institution)

3) Youth Volunteer Scholarship Award - \$500 – 1 Award (Deadline: Nov. 29th, 2013)

To be eligible for the Youth Volunteer Scholarship Award a student must:

- 1) Over the past 2 years a student must have completed a minimum of 50 hours of volunteer work.
- 2) Over the past 2 years a student must have maintained a GPA of 3.5 or greater.
- 3) A student must be under the age of 21 years of age on the day of the deadline.

4) Odenza Marketing Group Volunteer Scholarship - \$500 – 1 Award (Deadline: Dec. 30th, 2013)

To be eligible for the Odenza Marketing Group Volunteer Award a student must:

- 1) Be between the ages of 16 and 22 on December 30th, 2013
- 2) A student must also possess a GPA of 2.5 or higher in his/her last academic year.
- 3) A student must have contributed at least 50 hours of volunteer (non-paid) service within his/her community over the last 12 months. Please ensure that you have completed this amount of hours and that a person within the organization(s) is willing to confirm that you have volunteered this amount of time. (Note that we will only contact the organization(s) in the event that you are chosen as the scholarship award winner.)

5) Peter Pasula Study Habits Scholarship - \$500 – 1 Award (Deadline: April 1st, 2014)

To be eligible for the Study Habits Scholarship a student must:

- 1) Be attending an accredited post-secondary institution by the fall of 2014.
- 2) A student can be enrolled at any level in any program that is two years in length or longer.
- 3) Students must answer the essay question on the website online application form.

6) Maple Leaf Dentistry Scholarship - \$500 – 1 Award (Deadline: May 30th, 2014)

1. To be eligible a student must be attending school at the undergraduate level in the fall of 2014 and can be enrolled in any year of their undergraduate program. High School seniors who will graduate in 2014 are considered eligible. If you are attending a trades and/or technical school, the program must be at least 2 years in length or longer.

2. A student must have done at least 100 hrs of volunteer work over the last 2 years.

*You are required to name someone in the organization that can verify the time you spent participating in volunteer activities. We will only contact the individual you name in the event that you are chosen as the winner.

3. Have a GPA of 3.0 or higher in his/her last academic year.
