(indicate parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles, brothers, sisters, and close cousins)

The following pages should be attached to the 2-page resume:

- 1) Two letters of recommendation
- 2) Copy of transcript
- 3) An essay of no more than 500 words stating why the applicant plans to major in education
- 4) Student should sign and date the essay
