

Out-of-District Student Transfer Guidelines for 2017-18

Indiana Code 20-26-11-32 requires school districts to determine the capacity to accept out-of-district transfer students on an annual basis. To comply with this legislation, Southwestern Consolidated School District of Shelby County:

- will not be accepting any new out-of-district transfer applications for students entering grade 12 for the 2017-18 school year;
- will accept an unlimited number of out-of-district transfer applications for students entering kindergarten through entering students in the junior cohort for 2017-18 school year until the end of the day on the September count day (which is usually the first Friday after Labor Day);
- will continue to accept all applications from out-of-district transfer students entering any grade who were accepted and attended Southwestern during the 2016-17 school year, their siblings, and employees' children, as permitted by law.
